## **LIFEGUARD - (PART TIME)**

**Lifeguard:** (Part-time 19 hours with no benefits)

**Job Summary** – Enforce rules and ensure the safety of individuals using aquatic facilities and assist with various aquatic programs.

**Essential Functions:** Safeguard and regulate the conduct of patrons to prevent unsafe practices and accidents; Maintain a constant vigil over patrons in an assigned area; rescuing persons in distress; make frequent facility and equipment checks for safety; Responsible for the day to day cleanliness of the facility by performing light facility maintenance and custodial duties including, but not limited to lifting, sweeping, disposing of waste, vacuuming, and washing windows.

**Knowledge/Skills:** Standard Red Cross First Aid practices and water hazards, life saving techniques and cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

**Ability:** 1) Make correct decisions and act quickly in emergencies. 2) Render latest approved First Aid and artificial respiration procedures if needed. 3) Work a flexible schedule which may include some evenings, weekends, and holiday shifts. 4) Follow oral and written instructions and work cooperatively with others.

**License or Certification:** Must possess, at the time of employment and continuously throughout employment, a valid driver's license, Lifeguard Certifications, First Aid and CPR certificates.

**Education:** Must be at least 16 years old.

## **RECREATION AIDE - (PART TIME)**

**Recreation Aide:** (Part-time 19 hours with no benefits)

**Job Summary** – Assist in the supervision and operations of youth soccer activities and other recreation activities or special events.

**Essential Functions:** Assist in the supervision and operation of youth soccer activities and other recreation activities including but not limited to supervision, coaching, umpiring, refereeing, scorekeeping or others; Request, issue, and monitor the return of playground and athletic equipment; Check equipment for proper care and use; Responsible for the day to day cleanliness of the assigned area by performing light facility maintenance and custodial duties including, but not limited to lifting, sweeping, disposing of waste, vacuuming, and washing windows.

**Ability:** 1) Lead a variety of recreation activities or special events. 2) Work a flexible schedule which may include some evenings, weekends, and holiday shifts. 3) Follow oral and written instructions and work cooperatively with others.

**License or Certification:** Must possess, at the time of employment and continuously throughout employment, a valid driver's license and good driving record.

**Education:** Must be at least 16 years old.
